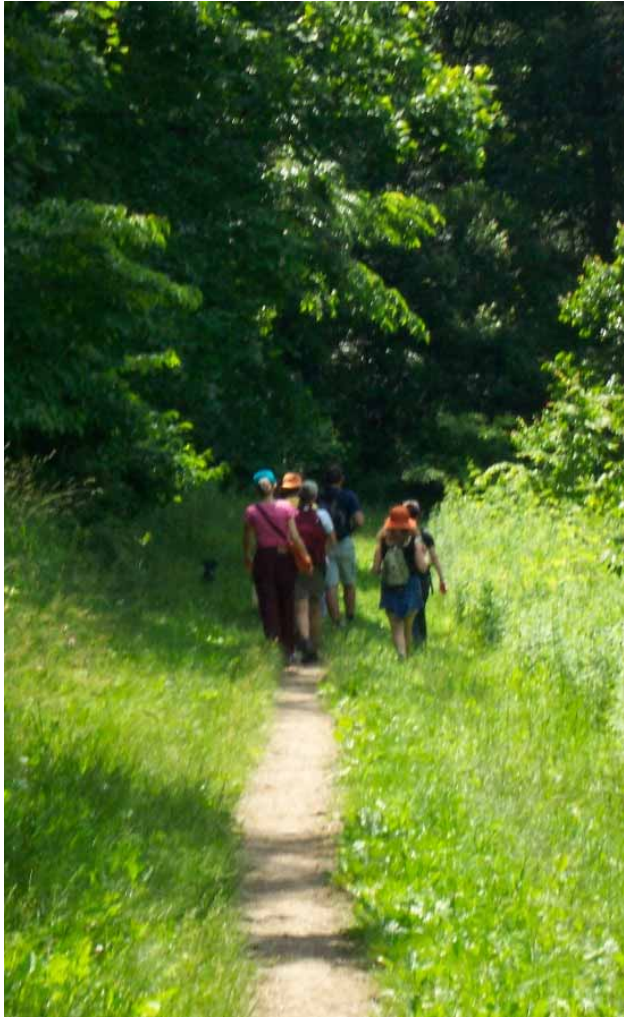


Getting it together in Dupont

Table **Ha**. All 5 inhabited continents are represented – we think.



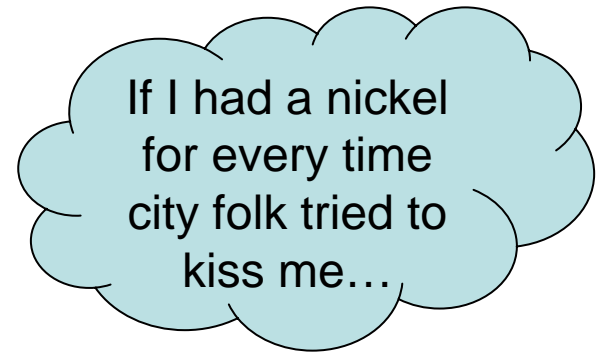
“Wait a minute – who’s from Africa?”

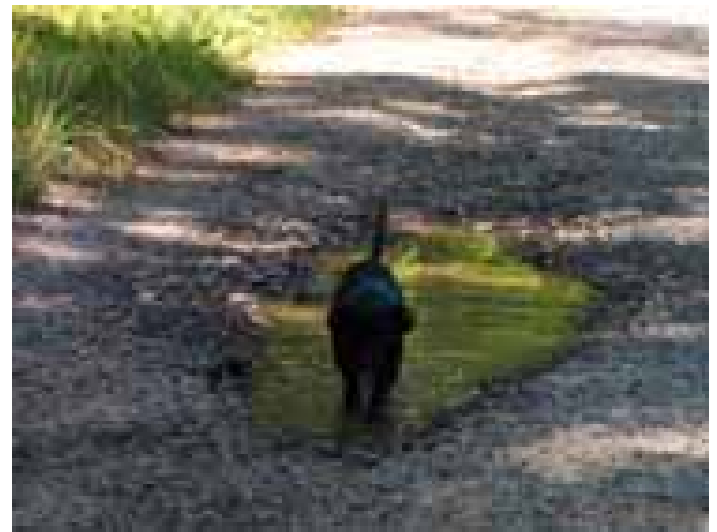
